The Astrée Ensemble is based in Turin and since it began in 1991 has collaborated with the Istituto per i Beni Culturali in Piedmont by proposing programmes which give ample space to eighteenth century Piedmontese authors and authors whose music is kept in the main libraries in Piedmont. The group take their name from a composition linked with Françoise Couperin Le Grand who at the end of the seventeenth century named LAstrée one of his Sonades en trio; he then added a dance suite calling the new opera La Piemontese and publishing it as Quatrième Ordre de Les Nations. The group has intense concert activities in Italy and abroad, very often with important organisations and festivals.
